

Karachi Inauguration Draw 2026 - Terms and Conditions

1. The Karachi inauguration draw (the “Draw”) is open to existing IKCA donors aged 18 or over who provide their Donor ID, full name, email address and contact number.
2. Employees, Trustees or agencies of Imran Khan Cancer Appeal (“IKCA”, “We”), their family members, or anyone else connected with the Draw may not enter.
3. By entering the Draw, entrants will be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.
4. No new donation is required to enter the Draw. If you have any questions about how to enter, please email support@ikca.org.uk.
5. Only one entry per person is permitted. Entries submitted on behalf of another person and joint entries will not be accepted.
6. IKCA accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt by IKCA.
7. The Draw closes at 23:59 on 31 October 2026. Entries received after this time will not be considered.
8. Two supporters will be selected at random from eligible entries received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
9. Selected supporters will be contacted by 2 November 2026 using the contact details supplied. They must respond within three days. If a selected supporter does not respond within that period, is ineligible or cannot accept the place, IKCA may select another eligible entrant.
10. The two selected supporters will each receive flight tickets, transfers and accommodation in connection with attending the official opening of Shaukat Khanum Karachi. Travel and accommodation arrangements will be organised by IKCA.
11. IKCA accepts no responsibility for any costs not specifically included in the travel arrangements. The arrangements include flight tickets, transfers and accommodation; any other costs will be the responsibility of the selected supporters.
12. IKCA will provide selected supporters with details of the travel and official opening arrangements directly.
13. The flight tickets, transfers and accommodation are provided solely for attendance at the official opening of Shaukat Khanum Karachi and cannot be used for a hospital visit on any other date. They are non-exchangeable, non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or any other benefit.

14. IKCA reserves the right to substitute attendance at the official opening and associated travel arrangements with an alternative of similar value if the original offering is no longer available.

15. Selected supporters consent to the use by IKCA and its related companies of their voice, image, photograph and name for publicity purposes, including still photographs, films, websites, advertising, marketing and promotional material, without additional compensation.

16. IKCA will use and protect any personal information you provide in accordance with its Privacy Policy and applicable data protection legislation. By entering the Draw, you agree that IKCA may collect, retain and use your personal information to process your entry, confirm your eligibility and contact you about the Draw.

17. IKCA accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, liability, injury or disappointment suffered as a result of entering the Draw or accepting the travel and attendance arrangements, except where liability cannot lawfully be excluded or limited.

18. IKCA reserves the right at any time to modify, suspend or discontinue the Draw, temporarily or permanently, without prior notice where this is necessary for reasons outside its reasonable control, including anticipated, suspected or actual fraud. IKCA's decision in relation to matters under its control will be final and binding.

19. IKCA shall not be liable for any failure to comply with its obligations where that failure is caused by circumstances outside its reasonable control. These may include, but are not limited to, adverse weather, fire, flood, strikes, industrial disputes, war, hostilities, political unrest, riots, terrorist attacks, civil commotion, accidents, changes in law or any other circumstances amounting to force majeure.

20. The Draw will be governed by English law and entrants submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.
